

IRB and Intro

Hello, we are researching online victimization and offending, and we would like to invite you to participate in our study. The following information is provided to inform you of the research project (IRB #19-1010) that will be conducted by Dr. Kati Parti, Dr. Thomas Dearden and Dr. James Hawdon.

PURPOSE OF THE STUDY: The purpose of this study is to investigate the experiences people have on the internet as it relates to both their victimization and offending experiences. We are trying to better understand the attitudes, behaviors, and situations that relate to said experiences.

PROCEDURES: You are being asked to complete an online questionnaire about computer use and online behaviors. If you decide to participate, completing the survey will require about ten minutes. The survey will include questions about demographic information, trust levels, political affiliation and beliefs, personal beliefs, social learning patterns, and self control. You will not be identified in any way, and your answers will remain confidential. There will be no way anyone will find out who you are or how you answered these questions. All results of this research will be reported in aggregate form so no individuals could be identified.

CONFIDENTIALITY: Collected survey data will be made publicly available after closing the study. Again, in the dataset no identifiers will be included, so no individuals could be identified.

RISKS: This survey will ask you questions about your online experiences. The questions include online behaviors that may be illegal though this information cannot be tied to anyone and is not sensitive enough to be incriminating. We believe this research poses no more than minimal risk. This risk includes potentially negative feelings such as anxiety, guilt, or general discomfort that may come when answering questions personal questions such as those about trust, victimization, and offending behaviors online. Typically, online surveys collect general information about the computer you are taking the survey on including IP Address. This feature has specifically been turned off to ensure anonymity in the survey.

BENEFITS: There is a societal benefit of increasing the understanding online behaviors, what relates to victimization and offending, and how beliefs and behaviors influence these situations.

COMPENSATION: There is no compensation for participation in this project other than that possibly provided by

Survey Sample International (SSI). .

FREEDOM TO WITHDRAW: By agreeing to participate in the study, you do not waive any rights that you may have regarding access to and disclosure of your records. Your participation in this study is completely voluntary. If you choose to participate, your responses will be held in confidence. You are free to withdraw at any time without penalty. In addition, you also understand that you may skip any question that you do not want to answer. Finally, if the results of this study were to be written for publication, no identifying information will be used.

The IRB has determined that this study meets the ethical obligations required by federal law and University policies.
